

During her academic tenure, she was entrusted with the role of Head of the Visual Arts Department in a college for 4 years of invaluable experience in leadership and curriculum development.

Beyond her involvement in street art creation, she is deeply passionate about arts education. she believes in the power of creativity and artistic expression to inspire and positively impact others' lives. Looking ahead, she is currently pursuing a Doctoral Degree, focusing on the study of creative arts education. Through this research, she aspires to delve deeper into the development of community art and contributes to the field of arts education.

Her thoughts and her goal


